## **Position Posting – Human Services Director**

Lac qui Parle County has a full-time opening for the position of Human Services Director I. Under the supervision of the County's Social Services Board, the Director is responsible for the overall administration of the Family Services Department, including management of a staff of 24 and an annual operations budget of around \$3 million.

Qualified candidates must possess a bachelor's degree from a four-year college or university with a major in social work, psychology, sociology, or closely related field <u>and</u> four years of line staff experience including two years of supervisory experience in the human services field. Alternatively, candidates may possess a bachelor's degree with a major in business, public administration, healthcare or related field and six years of line staff experience including two years of supervisory experience in the human services field. Candidates may be required to complete a background check and/or psychological profile.

The salary range for this position is \$75,000-\$113,000, dependent upon applicant qualifications. Other benefits include health insurance, PERA pension, retirement savings plan, and more.
