Extension of Emergency Declaration

WHEREAS, Lac qui Parle County, MN continues to suffer from the direct and indirect impacts of the COVID-19 Pandemic; and

WHEREAS, extensive impacts continue to affect individuals, businesses, schools, first responders, hospitals, and other services countywide; and

WHEREAS, subject matter experts and local public health have determined that the protective measures that must continue to be undertaken to reduce the impact of COVID-19 and will be above and beyond local capabilities and resources; and

WHEREAS, The Lac qui Parle County Department of Emergency Management has activated its Emergency Operations Center and is assisting in procuring and deploying resources, public information, and operational coordination; and

WHEREAS, The Lac qui Parle County Department of Emergency Management requests that the Lac qui Parle County Board Chair extends the Lac qui Parle County State of Local Emergency an additional 30 days due to the March 15th and ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic through May 19th 2020.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Chair of the Lac qui Parle Board of Commissioners hereby declare a STATE OF EMERGENCY in Lac qui Parle County, Minnesota for the next 30 days, due to the COVID-19 Pandemic which began on March 15, 2020, and requests coordination for the application of any state or federal assistance that may be available.

WITNESS my hand, acting on behalf of and for the people of Lac qui Parle County, I, Lac qui Parle County Board of Commissioners Chairman Todd Patzer, declare on the 21st day of April, 2020, that a STATE OF EMERGENCY continues to exist within Lac qui Parle County with all the powers and responsibilities attending thereto as provided by Chapter 12 of Minnesota Statutes.
