Actual Results	<p>Portions of the funding for this program are used to develop and maintain the County's GIS and Pictometry programs. These programs are used extensively for the administration of the shoreland program. There were 86 zoning and septic permits issued this year. Each permit application is reviewed for impacts to shoreland and/or floodplain. Of these 21 permits were further looked at and verified as to distance or impact to shoreland. Sixteen of these permits were looked at for impact to flood plain. Flood plain elevations are cross referenced and setbacks are verified. Extensive work was done on one permit application that was submitted with in the flood plain. Worked with property owner to find an alternative to the location chosen to construct a home. Flood plain managers training was attended in Benson. The Flood plain conference in Marshall was attended. Continue to work with the Watershed District in the implementation and enforcement of the Buffer Law. Field questions and assist County Residence with the interpretation of the County's Buffer Ordinance.</p>
