

## NOTICE OF MAIL BALLOT PROCEDURES TO VOTERS OF:

Cities of Boyd, Bellingham, Louisburg, Marietta and Nassau; Townships of Agassiz, Arena, Augusta, Baxter, Cerro Gordo, Freeland, Garfield, Hamlin, Hantho, Lac qui Parle, Lake Shore, Madison, Manfred, Mehurin, Perry, Providence, Ten Mile Lake, Walter and Yellow Bank

### In Lac qui Parle County, Minnesota

1. Beginning in 2016, voters in Cities of Bellingham and Boyd; Townships of Agassiz, Perry, and Walter in Lac Qui Parle County began voting entirely by mail in statewide elections as authorized by the township/city under MN Statutes 204B.45.
2. Beginning in 2018, voters in Cities of Louisburg, Marietta and Nassau; Townships of Arena, Augusta, Baxter, Cerro Gordo, Freeland, Garfield, Hamlin, Hantho, Lac qui Parle, Lake Shore, Madison Twp, Manfred, Mehurin, Providence, Ten Mile Lake, Walter and Yellow Bank in Lac Qui Parle County began voting entirely by mail in statewide elections as authorized by the township/city under MN Statutes 204B.45.
3. For 2022 statewide elections, the election dates and the corresponding dates that **ballots will automatically be mailed to all Registers Voters in mail ballot precincts** are:

Statewide Primary Elections: August 9, 2022

Ballot Mailing Dates: July 1 thru 26, 2022

Statewide General Election: November 8, 2022

Ballot Mailing Dates: September 23 thru October 25, 2022

All voters registered by July 19, 2022 for the Statewide Primary Election, and/or October 18, 2022 for the Statewide General Election will be mailed a ballot automatically.

4. Eligible voters not pre-registered by the dates noted, or pre-registered voters wishing to receive their ballot at a temporary address may contact the Lac Qui Parle County Auditor/Treasurer by phone, mail or in person for an application to receive a ballot.
5. Ballots may be returned by mail (a postage prepaid return envelope is included when the ballots are mailed), or delivered in person, or delivered by designated agent to:

Ballots must be received no later than 8:00 p.m. on election day in order to be counted. Normal business hours are Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

6. Extended hours for mail ballot voting are:

Statewide Primary Election: Saturday, August 6, 2022 from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.; Monday, August 8, 2022 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Statewide General Elections: Saturday, November 5, 2022 from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.; Monday, November 7, 2022 from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

7. The polling place Mail Ballot Precincts will be at Lac Qui Parle County Courthouse.

The polls will be open:

Statewide Primary Election: Tuesday, August 14, 2018 from 8:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Statewide General Election: Tuesday, November 6, 2018 from 8:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

At least one Omni Ballot marking machine will be available at the polling place that permit persons with disabilities to vote privately and independently.
