

RESOLUTION FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A  
COUNTY ANIMAL FEEDLOT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency has established an animal feedlot program designed to assist animal feedlot operators in efficient and environmentally sound management of animal wastes; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency's program provides for county involvement in the processing of animal feedlot permit applications in accordance with Minn. Stat. §116.07 subd. 7 (1978) and 6 MCAR 4.8051-52; and

WHEREAS, Minn. Stat. §116.07 subd. 7 (1978) and 6 MCAR 4.8052B provides that a county may assume certain responsibilities for the program through the adoption of a resolution; and

WHEREAS, the County of Lac qui Parle wishes to assume certain responsibilities for the processing of animal feedlot permit applications in accordance with Minn. Stat. §116.07 subd. 7 (1978), 6 MCAR 4.8051-52, and as specified in the attached statement describing permit application processing procedures;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lac qui Parle County Board of Commissioners that the County of Lac qui Parle assumes certain responsibilities for the processing of animal feedlot permit applications in accordance with Minn. Stat. §116.07 subd. 7 (1978), 6 MCAR 4.8051-52 and the attached statement describing permit processing procedures;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County appoints Marlyn Hanson as the County Feedlot Pollution Control Officer and that the County Feedlot Pollution Control Officer will:

(a) Distribute permit application forms made available by the Director of the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency to those required to make application for the permit; and

(b) Provide, where requested, assistance to the applicants to insure that application forms are properly completed; and

(c) Receive and review completed application forms and conduct such inspections as necessary to determine if the proposed animal feedlot will comply with applicable state rules and regulations and applicable local ordinances; and

(d) Issue Certificates of Compliance in accordance with 6 MCAR 4.8051 - 4.8052; and

(e) Maintain a record of all correspondence and material relating to animal feedlot permit applications, certificates of compliance and interim permits issued by the County; and

(f) Provide such other tasks which are delineated within or incidental to the attached statement dealing with permit application processing procedures;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County agrees to notify the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency in writing of any changes in the program as outlined herein and attached hereto;

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the County of Lac qui Parle respectfully submits this resolution and the attached statement describing permit processing procedures to the Minnesota Pollution

Control Agency and respectfully requests that the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency approves the County's participation in the animal feedlot program.
